The exhibition at the Arnaud Lefebvre Gallery will present newly restored work by Hessie. It will be the first exhibition since the recent death of the artist. The works have been selected for the visible traces they bear of their previous condition. They are made on textile or on paper. Time and poor storage conditions had all but ruined them. Left to their state of neglect, they would have disappeared.

Each of the works has reacted in its own way to this fate. Some have come through this long period of silence relatively intact. Others have greatly suffered. But they all came through the physical deterioration wrought by time within the very same home where Hessie lived. They are survivors and there is a great beauty in the story each of them tells us today.

The photos of Domingo Djuric are quite beautiful. Photography is his medium. As Yanitza Djuric has written, "As for Domingo, it seems to me that cameras, from his earliest childhood, have been his only "toy soldiers", long before that play became more serious some years later. "Give art its childhood..."

The choice of photos in this show aims to share the world of Hessie through the works of her son, the way photography hides and reveals at the same time.






HESSIE, [untitled] (No.Inv. 134) Purple confetti and green paint on orange paper, 19.69 x 25.59 inches.




